



## Erin's Law Instructional Packages

### K-5 Instructional Content

The K-5 instructional content consists of online lesson plans used by teachers, who provide direct instruction to their students in a classroom setting. Links to instructional resources, such as activities, handout materials, and assessments, are included in each lesson plan. Teachers are provided detailed, step-by-step direction and every resource they need to deliver the material to their students.

### Middle and High School Content

Both the middle and high school instructional content consist of lessons designed for students to work through independently, or with the assistance of their teacher. The package can serve as a standalone course or be integrated into an existing course. Spider Learning, Inc., uses the suggested content and activities provided by a state and changes the audience from teacher-facing to student-facing, thereby changing the role of the teacher from instructor to facilitator. Lessons include an objective, a hypothetical situation for the student to consider, a question posed to the student, content that answers the question, a summary of the content, and three assessment questions, each with a distractor rationale and a one-sentence explanation of the correct answer. Images are also included to make the material more engaging for students.
